# Preschool October Newsletter

The first month of school seemed to fly by and now we're off and running! October marks the start of parties and festivities so please make sure to read your newsletters carefully. Make note of party dates, sign-ups for fieldtrip drivers and party treats.

September was the month for getting acquainted. We're getting to know the routine, our classrooms and each other. We're making new friends and learning how to get along in our classroom.

Last month we had a lot of fun playing with different tactile materials that offered a sensory experience as well. We scooped and poured cinnamon popping oats and coffee sand at the sensory tables. We shaped and molded playdough and kinetic sand. We painted with mashers, cars, salad spinners, golf balls and spinner boards. We played with Ooblick and watched how it changes from a solid to a liquid when you squeeze and let go!

Last month we also had a full experience with apples. We cooked them, painted with them, ate them, sorted them, learned their names, cored and peeled them with a cool apple "machine" and read lots of books about them.

We've been focusing in on the children's interests and have some great themes planned for the future months. Our themes coming up in October are Autumn, Harvest, Pumpkins and Halloween.
